Weekly Reflection



What is the true source of happiness? The Lord answers this question by saying: “*Remain in me,*” (John 15:4). This is the great secret in Christian’s life. Our life in Christ is the source of our true happiness.

The psalmist says: “*Delight in the Lord, and He will give you the requests of your heart,*” (Psalm 37). During his works in India, Saint Francis Xavier was so fulfilled with divine consolations that he used to exclaim: “*Enough, O Lord, enough.*” Where has any lover of this world been found so satisfied with the possessions of earthly goods as to say: “*Enough, worldly goods, enough; no more riches, no more honors, no more pleasures?*” Precisely the opposite, things in this world are never completely satisfying, and for this reason, people seek higher honors, greater riches, and new pleasures. But the more they have of them, the less their desires are satisfied.

You must persuade yourself of this truth: God alone can give complete happiness, the fullness of joy. This is what Saint Augustine learned when he was far from God and still in His search: “*All things are hard, O Lord, and you alone give repose.*” Once again, hear Jesus saying: “*Remain in me,*” (John 15:4). You may ask: “*Why Lord are you asking me to remain in you?*” And He will tell you: “*I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete,*” (John 15:11).

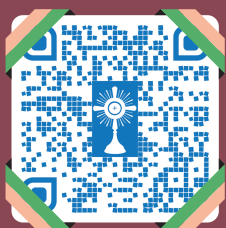
Perpetual Adoration in Ave

El salmista dice: “*Pon tus delicias en el Señor, y El te dará lo que pida tu corazón,*” (Salmo 37). Durante su viaje por la India, San Francisco Javier fue tan bendecido por los consuelos de Dios que decía: “*Basta, Señor, basta.*”

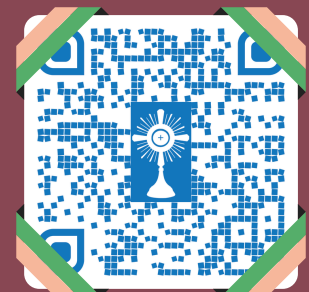
