
August 13-14, 2022 | Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

AVE MARIA CATHOLIC CHURCH



In 1950, Venerable Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven as a dogma of faith: "The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." The liturgical celebration of the Assumption takes place on August 15th.

With her Assumption, Our Blessed Mother entered into the fullness of union with God. From heaven, the Blessed Virgin Mary draws us onwards and accompanies us on our journey.

In our celebration of the Assumption, let us recall the advice of St. Bernard of Clairvaux (b. 1090- d. 1153): "In dangers, in doubts, in difficulties, think of Mary, call upon Mary. Let not her name depart from your lips, never suffer it to leave your heart. And that you may obtain the assistance of her prayer, neglect not to walk in her footsteps. With her for guide, you shall never go astray; while invoking her, you shall never lose heart; so long as she is in your mind, you are safe from deception; while she holds your hand, you cannot fall; under her protection, you have nothing to fear; if she walks before you, you shall not grow weary; if she shows you favor, you shall reach the goal" (Homily II on the text Missus est).

This year the feast of the Assumption is not a Holy Day of Obligation; nevertheless, let us be close to our Blessed Mother by participating in Holy Mass or praying the Rosary. We always need her, and she always cares for us!

Donahue Academy WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL!

The academic year is off to a great start at Donahue Academy, our parish school.

Tomorrow is the Feast of the Assumption and a day off of school for all students; we hope everybody grows closer to Our Lady as they celebrate this special day.

Our Junior class will be on retreat Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday of this week. Please remember them in your prayers as they begin their penultimate year of high school.

The first Community & Culture Night of the year is coming up later this month at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, August 31st at the school.

Community & Culture Nights educate parents on the strong Catholic identity, unique classical curriculum, and particular Ave Maria culture of Donahue Academy.

The first evening provides an overview of Catholic, classical education and defines the Donahue difference. School Principal Dr. Guernsey will begin the evening with his keynote, "Catholic and Classical: An Unbeatable Duo." Religious Education

Confirmation Preparation: Confirmation is a two-year preparation process (9th/10th grades). In year-one most of the preparation is participating in Youth Ministry on Sunday evening (see below). In year-two, continued participation in Youth Ministry along with formal preparation classes during the week. 2nd year Confirmation classes start Wednesday, October 19th, from 6:30-8:00 pm at Donahue Academy.

Youth Ministry DTS (Dead Theologians Society): The Dead Theologians Society is a Catholic apostolate for junior/high school age teens. Through the saints of yesterday, the program inspires the youth of today to become the saints of tomorrow. Regular scheduled DTS sessions start Sunday, September 18, 2022, from 6:30-8:00 pm in the Parish Hall.

RCIA/OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults):

Adults receiving or completing their Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation) to be received at Easter Vigil in the spring. Classes start Wednesday, September 19, 2022, from 6:30-8:00 pm at the Donahue Academy Library.

Adult Confirmation: Adults that have received the sacraments of Baptism and Eucharist and need to complete the Sacraments of Initiation at parish Confirmation in the spring. Classes start Wednesday, September 19, 2022, from 6:30-8:00 pm at the Donahue Academy Library.

Reflexión Semanal



En 1950, el Venerable Papa Pío XII definió el dogma de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María a los cielos como dogma de fe: "La Inmaculada Madre de Dios, la siempre Virgen Maria, habiendo completado el curso de su vida en la tierra, fue asumpta cuerpo y alma a la gloria del cielo." La celebracion litúrgica de la Asunción tiene lugar el 15 de agosto.

Con la Asunción, Nuestra Santísima Madre entró a la plenitud de unión con Dios. Desde el cielo, la Santísima Virgen María nos atrae hacia lo alto y nos acompaña en nuestra peregrinación.

En nuestra celebración de la Asunción, recordemos el consejo de San Bernado de Claraval (1090-1153): "En los peligros, en las dudas, en las dificultades, piensa en María, llama a María. No dejes que su nombre se aparte de tus labios y nunca permitas que se aparte de tu corazón. Para obtener las súplicas de tus plegarias, nunca dejes de caminar siguiendo de sus pasos. Con Ella como guía, no te perderás; invocándola, nunca te decepcionarás; mientras Ella esté en tu mente, estás protegido de todo engaño; mientras Ella te sostiene de la mano, no te tropezarás; bajo su protección, no tienes nada que temer; si ella camina delante de ti, tu no te cansarás; si ella te muestra su favor, alcanzarás la meta," (Homilía II, Missus est).

Este año, la fiesta de la Asunción no es un día de precepto, sin embargo, permanezcamos cerca de nuestra Madre participando de la Santa Misa o rezando el Santo Rosario. Nosotros siempre la necesitamos y Ella siempre cuida de nosotros!




