Weekly Reflection



This weekend we are enjoying the presence of 450 young people attending the **13th Annual Youth Conference "Fearless,"** hosted by Ave Maria University. To be young is a gift. In a sense, young people have their entire life before them. That is a gift, and that is a tremendous challenge!

What would be a good piece of advice for the young? Let us listen to the Apostle and Evangelist St. John: *"I write to you, young people because you are strong and the word of God remains in you, and you have conquered the evil one. Do not love the world. . . because the world is passing away. But whoever does the will of God remains forever"* (1 Jn 2:14-15, 17).

Let me write to the young among us and show them three fundamental ideas:

First, you have the gift of strength. You have physical strength. You are not afraid of bruises or sickness. You also have spiritual strength. You have great dreams and desires.

Second, this world is passing away, look for what remains forever. Then, do not invest your gifts in things that will betray, rob, and bankrupt you. Time in this life is very precious and goes away quickly. Use your time wisely.

Third, whoever does God's will remain forever. This is the best investment of your energies. In your prayer, ask God to show you the path to the eternal happiness He has prepared for you. Ask God to show you your vocation in life. And when He answers: follow His lead!

Testimony of Ave Maria Parishioner Paul Dinan: "What does it mean to be an altar boy?"

I have asked myself that question countless times over the last ten years, I have had the privilege to don a cassock and surplice and assist at the altar: at the holy and eternal altar of sacrifice, where 'even angels falter, bowed low in reverent prayer.'

The altar server truly is at the service of both Christ and his ordained ministers... swinging the thurible and watching the smoke rise to heaven with the prayers of the people...clasp the communion plate with trembling hands while Father retrieves a Host laying on its surface... holding the canopy steadily over our Eucharistic Lord in procession while trying to ignore the sweat trickling down your forehead...watching intently as God descends into the hands of the priest only a few feet away...this is both the glory and the responsibility of an altar boy.

And yet, I have gradually come to see that servers have one duty that surpasses any other, namely, to remain always prayerful and attentive to the miracle unfolding before our eyes. If any wandering eyes from the congregation were to fall on him, they should be led through his example back to Christ on the altar. He must at every Mass echo along with all the angels and saints at his side 'not to us Lord, not to us, but to your name give glory!'"

Donahue Academy

Our Parish School's Class of 2022 received an average score of 1310 on their SAT, and three students scored above 1500. Based on data from *Private School Review*, Donahue Academy has the highest average score of any in-person Catholic school in Florida and the highest average score of any school in Southwest Florida. Our School is the highest-scoring school in the Diocese of Venice, consistently beating the state and national average by well over 100 points.

The remarkable academic achievements of our Parish School are supported by the foundational principles on which it stands. Donahue Academy is listed on the *Catholic Education Honor Roll of The Cardinal Newman Society*.

The *Honor Roll* criteria conform (since 2017) to the *Principles of Catholic Identity in Education*, which *The Cardinal Newman Society* has derived from Church teaching and guidance on elementary and secondary education. These Principles are:

1. Inspired by Divine Mission
2. Models Christian Communion
3. Encounters Christ in Prayer, Scripture, and Sacrament
4. Integrally Forms the Human Person
5. Imparts a Christian Understanding of the World
