



#### **MARRIAGE & FAMILY LIFE**


AVE MARIA PARISH MINISTRY

The Ave Maria Parish Ministry "Marriage and Family Life" has two components.

1. "Together in Holiness" is the parish marriage preparation program. As St. John Paul II famously said, "As goes the family, so goes the nation, and so goes the entire world in which we live." During the marriage preparation, mentor couples present God's plan for marriage and family to the engaged couple and future spouses.



2. "Transformed Marriages" is the parish ongoing formation program for married couples. This program offers spiritual support and formation. Saint Paul introduces this "transformation" in his letter to Romans 12:2: "Be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect."



The Marriage and Family Life Ministry is organizing the first "Ave Maria Parish Marriage and Family Life Retreat," Friday, August 19, and Saturday, August 20, 2022. The retreat will take place at Donahue Academy and will be directed by Deacon Larry Oney. Deacon Oney is an experienced and prolific orator, who has spoken at hundreds of events and appeared on many EWTN shows; including The World Over with Raymond Arroyo and EWTN Live with Fr. Mitch Pacwa. He has also been a guest on FOCUS TV, Franciscan Radio, Ave Maria Radio, Relevant Radio, Redeemer Radio and many other great media outlets.

#### FRATERNUS In Ave Maria




