Weekly Reflection



A brief sentence of the Canticle of Canticles (1:3) captures in just few words what a priest is or should be: "Draw me and we shall run after you..." The attraction of God is the origin of every priestly vocation. God, who is the three times Holy, the Creator, the Redeemer, and the Sanctifier, is the one who draws priests to Himself.

Love is communicable, for this reason, in *The Story of a Soul*, Therese of Lisieux exclaims: "O Jesus, it is not even necessary to say: 'When drawing me, draw the souls whom I love!' This simple statement: 'Draw me' suffices. I understand, Lord, that when a soul allows herself to be captivated by you, she cannot run alone, all the souls whom she loves follow her train. This is done without constraint, without effort, it is natural consequence of her attraction for You."

Father Alex Pince may God bless your priestly ministry! Mary was at the foot of the Cross; She is at the priest's altar on the day of ordination; She assists us priests in every Mass, giving us the grace to deepen on our consecration. May She lead you ever closer to Jesus, and then, together with you, many souls will run after Him!



Prayer of the Week


Sub Tuum Praesidium





Congratulations Fr. Alex Pince!

Father Alex Pince was ordained at 11:00 a.m. on July 31, 2021, at Epiphany Cathedral, Venice.

Fr. Pince is the middle of seven children. His parents have been strong witnesses of Faith as he explains: "I was blessed to have been given the Faith from my parents (David and Margaret Pince), and from when I was a child, my mom took us to daily Mass." Then, he remembers: "That habit continued through my high school years. I started altar serving after my

first Communion at the age of six, and I looked up to our Parish priest, who earnestly cautioned me: 'altar serving isn't kid stuff.'"

Homeschooled with a Catholic curriculum through high school, then he attended Ave Maria University, earning degrees in business and economics. Father Pince remembers those years with gratitude: "I loved my time as a student at Ave Maria and loved the area."

Father Pince earned a philosophy degree at St. John Vianney College Seminary in Miami. He then went on to study in Rome, and earned a Sacred Theology bachelor's degree (STB) from the Gregorian University. He will soon be entering the second year of a two-year licentiate program in Rome at the University of the Holy Cross in moral theology. (Taken from *Florida Catholic*).

Unas breves palabras del Cantar de los Cantares (1:3) captan lo que el sacerdote es o debe ser: "Atráeme y correremos hacia Ti." La atracción de Dios es el origen de la vocación sacerdotal. Dios que es tres veces Santo, el Creador, el Redentor, y el Santificador, es quien atrae a los sacerdotes hacia Él.

En su libro, "Those Mysterious Priests" el Venerable Fulton Sheen indica que: "La medida en la que un sacerdote atrae almas a Cristo es también la misma medida en que el sacerdote está cerca de Él."

El amor es comunicativo, por eso Santa Teresita del Niño Jesús exclama: "Decir 'atráeme' es suficiente, porque cuando un alma se deja cautivar por Dios, el alma no pude correr sola, y las almas que ella ama la siguen . . . es la consecuencia natural de la atracción por Dios." ¡Que Dios bendiga tu ministerio Padre Alex Pince! María estubo a los pies de la Cruz junto a Jesús ; Ella está junto al Altar el día de la ordenación; Ella asiste a los sacerdotes en la celebración de cada Misa.
