

Weekly Reflection



On Thursday, September 22, we will resume the Catholic Culture Series. Dr. Timothy O'Malley, author of the book "Off the Hook: God, Love, Dating, and Marriage in a Hookup World," will deliver a lecture on *Friendship with the Beloved: A Catholic Vision of Dating and Marriage in a Hookup World*.

The Catholic Culture Series fosters a genuine understanding of the incarnation of the Gospel. The Gospel of Jesus Christ and the power of his grace are the radical cure for our human nature (fallen because of sin) and human culture.

A fundamental event transformed humanity: "The Word became flesh and dwelt among us," (Jn 1:14). He came to heal and elevate our nature. He came to heal and elevate our culture.

Following the example of Christ, who judged and condemned the negative values of his time, we must continually evaluate the limitations and errors of the culture in which we live in light of the Gospel.

We must recognize a culture's riches, and, at the same time, we must reject the negative values of a culture that separate humanity from its Creator. The incarnation of the Gospel in a culture signifies the conversion of that culture to the Gospel and the profound purification of that culture.





Ave Maria Faith Formation classes are starting soon!

Children's Eucharistic Adoration-Jean Prather (Catholic Kids 101) leads children of all ages in reflections, stories, prayers, and the rosary. Weekly adoration sessions are on Mondays, from 7:00-8:00 pm in the Church.

St. Margaret Castello Ministry-Sacramental Development for persons with special needs and their families. Classes start Friday, September 30th, with adoration from 6:30-7:00 pm in the Church and continuing catechesis in the parish hall until 8:00 pm.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS)-**Kindergarten and First Grade** (1st year First Communion Preparation): A reflective-based program of religious formation that is rooted in Scripture and the Liturgy. Starting Sunday, September 11, 2022, from 11:15 am -12:15 pm in the CGS Atrium, 3rd floor of the bank building.

2nd Year First Communion Preparation: the core of the program is the Catholic Children's Bible. The students will explore the sacraments through the biblical lens of Jesus' life and works and learn more about their faith in a language they can understand.
