

Weekly Reflection



From Monday, March 21 to Thursday, March 24, a group of missionaries from Ave Maria Parish will visit the entire community. This Outreach Mission is part of our Lenten Parish Program, but most significantly is what defines us as Catholics.

As Catholics, we participate in the mission of Christ. The apostles were indeed confessors of the name of Jesus. Saint Peter declared before the Sanhedrin: *"There is no salvation through anyone else, nor is there any other name under heaven given to the human race by which we are to be saved,"* (Acts 4, 9–12).

Why, then, is there so much hesitation in proclaiming Christ's name to the world? In his Encyclical Letter *Redemptoris Missio*, Saint John Paul II tells us:

"Nowadays, the call to conversion is seen as an act of "proselytizing." It is claimed that it is enough to help people become more human or faithful to their religion; that it is enough to build communities capable of working for justice, freedom, peace, and solidarity. What is overlooked is that every person has the right to hear the "Good News" of the God who reveals and gives himself in Christ, so that each one can live out in its fullness their proper calling."

People have the right to hear Jesus's name preached to them, and we Catholics have the obligation to proclaim his name. Then, we can also say with Saint Paul: *"For an obligation has been imposed to me, and woe to me if I do not preach [the gospel],"* (1 Cor. 9, 16).




PARISH CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Religious Education Welcome RCIA Elect and Candidates!

We are very proud of our RCIA families and sponsors that participated in the Rite of Sending (at Ave Maria) and The Rite of Election (at the Cathedral in Venice) on March 6. In the Diocese of Venice, an estimated 400 Elect (Catechumens) and Candidates will be entering the Church on Easter Vigil. *"God is always faithful to those he calls,"* (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, 133).

When an adult seeks to be baptized, the Church is always looking for signs in that person's life of God at work. Here are some signs we look for: Does the person listen to God's word and respond to it? Have they changed their way of life to match the way of life presented in the Gospel? Do they pray with the Church and do the things the Church does? Do they live a spirit of charity in their family and work-life? When we see these signs in the person's life, we can affirm that God has chosen them to be baptized.

This discernment, testimony, and election are formally ritualized in the Church's ancient Rite of Election. This rite is the turning point for those seeking to be baptized. Their months of preparation take the final turn because the Church recognizes that God has chosen them to be baptized at the Easter Vigil. This rite, which takes place at the beginning of Lent, propels them and the Church into the final preparations for the great Easter celebration.

Please continue to pray and support our RCIA families as they near their entrance into the Church. *"You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide,"* (John 15:16)

Reflexión Semanal



Desde el lunes 21 de marzo hasta el jueves 24 de marzo, un grupo de misioneros de la Parroquia de Ave Maria visitará a toda la comunidad. Esta Misión Popular es parte de nuestro programa parroquial de Cuaresma pero de modo más significativo es lo que nos define como católicos. Como católicos, nosotros participamos de la misión de Cristo. Los apóstoles fueron verdaderos confesores del nombre de Jesús. San Pedro declaró delante del Sanedrín: *"No existe bajo el cielo otro Nombre dado a los hombres, por el cual podamos alcanzar la salvación,"* (Hechos 4, 12).

¿Por qué, entonces, hay tantas dudas de proclamar el nombre de Jesús al mundo? En su Carta Encíclica *Redemptoris Missio*, San Juan Pablo II nos dice: *"En nuestros días, el llamado a la conversión es visto como un acto de 'proselitismo.' Se dice que es suficiente ayudar a las personas a que sean más humanas o más fieles a su religion, que es suficiente construir comunidades capaces de trabajar por la justicia, la libertad, la paz, y la solidaridad. Lo que no se tiene en cuenta es que toda persona tiene el derecho de escuchar la "Buena Noticia" del Dios que se revela y se nos da en Cristo, para que cada uno pueda vivir en plenitud el propio llamado."* Las personas tienen derecho a que se les predique el nombre de Jesús, y nosotros católicos tenemos la obligación de proclamar su nombre. Entonces, podemos también decir con San Pablo: *"Si anuncio el Evangelio, no lo hago para gloriarme: al contrario, es para mí una necesidad imperiosa. ¡Ay de mí si no predicara el Evangelio!"* (1 Cor. 9: 16).


