# Weekly Reflection



In Holy Scriptures we find the symbol of the potter who “fashions” his artistic creation just as it is said about the creation of man in the Book of Genesis: “The Lord God formed man out of the clay of the ground,” (Gn. 2: 7). Indeed, these are the words that the prophet Jeremiah hears from God: “Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand,” (Jer. 18:6).

Job recalls this image, despite being battered and bruised by suffering: “Your hands have formed me and fashioned me . . . Remember that you fashioned me from clay!” (Job 10: 8-9). Also, the prophet Isaiah proclaims: “Lord, you are our father; we are the clay and you our potter: we are all the work of your hand,” (Isaiah 64:7)

When Venerable Fulton Sheen decided to write his autobiography, he chose this title: “Treasure in Clay.” That is what we are! We are clay in God’s hand. The touch of God’s hand is a miracle of life and grace! He gives us minds and hearts so that we can know and love Him. He gives us His grace so that we can enjoy Him forever! Let’s thank God because we are treasures in clay. Let’s ask Him to mold us as He wishes.

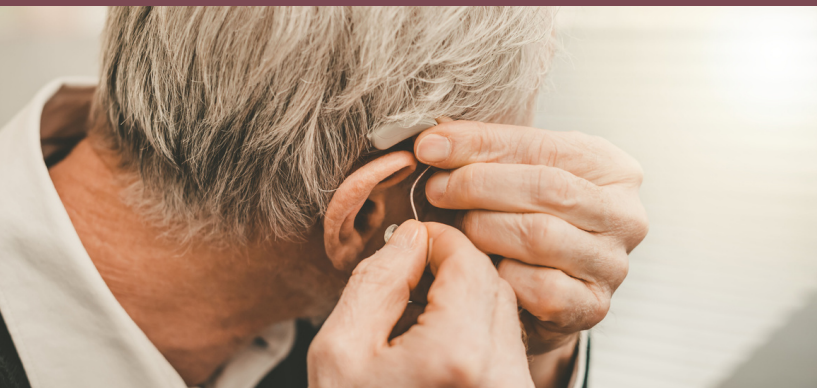

## Hearing Assistance Installed

---

Dear Fellow Parishioners,

During the week of July 5th, when the church was closed for needed maintenance, Ave Maria Parish installed a two-part hearing assistance system. The first is a T-Coil Induction Loop system which is compatible with most hearing aids and loop receivers. This requires no user set up and will simply work inside of the Church. The second is a wireless system that will work on most mobile devices and their paired earbuds by

downloading the "Audio Fetch" application from your phone's app/google store.

How to listen to the Mass with Audio Fetch:

- Inside Ave Maria Parish connect your mobile device to our "Ave Maria Parish Audio Fetch" Wi-Fi.
  - Only the first time that you are connected to "Ave Maria Parish Audio Fetch" Wi-Fi it will ask you if you want to use this network without internet access, need to accept "Used without Internet"
- Open your "Audio Fetch" application.
- Listen to the mass using your wire headphones or Bluetooth headphones paired to your mobile device.

These new hearing assistance systems were made possible through the generous support of many people in our Ave Maria Parish Community. Their generosity will help many of your fellow parishioners with the gift of hearing the Word of God during Mass, the rosary, and concerts held in the church. ## Reflexión Semanal



En la Sagrada Escritura encontramos el símbolo del alfarero que “forma” su creación artística, su obra maestra, tal como se relata la creación del hombre en el libro del Génesis: “Entonces Yahvé Dios formó al hombre con polvo de la tierra,” (Gen. 2:7). Estas son las palabras que el profeta Jeremías escucha de parte de Dios: “Como el barro en la mano del alfarero, así eres tú en mi mano,” (Jer. 18:6). Job recuerda esta imagen a pesar de los golpes y heridas de su sufrimiento: “Tus manos me han modelado, me han formado . . . Acuérdate que me amasaste como el barro,” (Job 10: 8-9).

Finalmente, el profeta Isaías proclama: “Señor, tu eres nuestro Padre; nosotros somos el barro y tu nuestro alfarero: nosotros somos la obra de tus manos,” (Isaías 64:7). Cuando el Venerable Fulton Sheen decidió escribir su autobiografía, el eligió este título: “Un Tesoro en Barro.” ¡Y eso es lo que somos!

Nosotros somos arcilla en las manos de Dios. ¡Que tesoro tan grande! ¡El toque de la mano de Dios es un milagro de la vida y de la gracia! Él nos da nuestra mente para que lo podamos conocer.
