

# Weekly Reflection

During this week in Advent, let us turn to Mary, Our Blessed Mother. We just celebrated her feast of the Immaculate Conception. Let us turn to Our Lady, the Immaculate Virgin Mary, who is full of grace, the all-beautiful Lady, and ask her for the grace of conversion. May we also say our "yes" to God with the same determination that She said hers.

We must turn to Mary because she is the Mother of our Savior, Jesus. She is the Mother of Mercy, and for that reason, she is our hope. When we turn to Mary, our confidence should be greater because she is our Mother too. She is our Mother not by the flesh but spiritually; She is the Mother of our souls and our salvation.

Did She not say that in the message of Guadalupe? These were her words to Juan Diego: "Listen and understand, my littlest son, let nothing frighten and afflict you or trouble your heart ... Am I not here, I, who am your mother? Are you not under my shadow? Am I not your health? Are you not by chance held in my mantle?" Those words were directed not only to St. Juan Diego but also to each one of us.

Let us always turn to Mary, not only during this week of Advent, when we remember her Immaculate Conception and her message of Guadalupe, but every day of our lives, and let us pray with confidence: "Holy Mary Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death." Amen



The purpose of this program is to provide Ave Maria residents in need of grocery assistance with non-perishable groceries once a month.

If you are interested in requesting grocery assistance, please complete the Assistance Request online form.



Once you complete the form you will be contacted by a Brother Knight to notify you of your level of assistance and when to you can expect to receive your first delivery.

Grocery bags will be delivered to your home and left without contact. You will be notified electronically of the delivery.

The plan is to provide one to two bags of non-perishable groceries per month to each recipient's family. Each bag is expected to feed a family of four for a week.



# Feast of the Immaculate Conception

A reflection from Dr. Michael Dauphinais, Chair and Professor of Theology at AMU, on the Feast of the Immaculate Conception

"On this Feast, the archangel Gabriel greets Mary, "Hail, full of grace." This greeting already hints at the reality that Mary is conceived preserved from original sin; since Mary has no obstacle to grace, she is truly "full of grace." St. Thomas teaches that grace accords with the dual mission of the Son and the Spirit indwelling us. Mary's grace is not her own but that which she receives from Jesus Christ, as John teaches, "from his fulness have we all received, grace upon grace" (John 1:16). Mary is the perfect temple of her Son and His Spirit, first according to their indwelling in her soul and later, in the very flesh of the child Jesus indwelling in her womb. With her assistance, let us invite Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit to dwell in us in this life and in the life to come."

When my family gets near the Basilica, we hold hands really tight, like a chain, and walk through the crowd that way so we don't get separated. I see people singing and dancing in the streets. I see people playing quitars and pounding their drums. I see families with lots of children everywhere. I see people on their knees praying the Rosary. I see people walking on their knees and praying. I see people holding up their arms to Heaven in prayer... Grandpa told me many of the people walk for miles to make it to Mexico City in time for the feast. Many people sleep on the streets because there are no rooms available. Despite the hardships, people are so happy! They just want to be there for the big day to honor Our Lady! And here is why they come..."


